In his blog, <u>http://www.blondelimbo.com</u>, **Christopher Mason Taylor** has offered some powerful insight on how this may have come to be while **Simon Tyrrell's themacgroove.co.uk** shows how he has been expanding Apple's world for years. While **Jane Sanford Harrison's** worlds of design, travel and genealogy are busier than mine, **Sara Nichols** showed off her media talents to add her appreciation of the web to the petition.

And there is much more out there! This has also been percolating in the <u>Apple</u> <u>Support Communities</u> discussions for several months with hundreds of postings that address the <u>web hosting and iCloud</u> issues with the views now approaching 14,000. **Remy Leroy** added this <u>Command Guru</u> Petition to the cause with remarkable results in a week <u>http://cloudpetition.commandguru.com/</u> as shown here. What is needed is more visibility of what we aggregate here. Share the <u>Petition Link</u> with your Apple friends and get them on board. High visibility attention and celebrity support would also help. This is the message to Apple.
